

4-H Online Tips for Enrollment

While 4H online is not a new system to the Ohio 4-H Program, it will be brand new to our families in Seneca County. This system is not only accessible from your laptop or desktop but it is mobile friendly so you can use it on your phone or tablet!

The county deadline for enrollment is March 20, 2021 – however, your club leaders may have established an earlier date for club purposes. Please use the steps below to complete your enrollment.

- Visit <http://oh.4honline.com/> to enroll
- Returning members/families already have an account. Please enter your family email, which your advisor has a list of emails, and select forgot password. Reset password and log in.
- If you or another of your family members are already in the program or have been in recent years – please do not create a new profile. Contact the office for assistance.
- The registration process allows you to update personal information annually such as; age, grade, contact information and years in projects etc.
- Years in a project should automatically calculate, please check for accuracy.
- All cloverbuds should be enrolled in project 715: My Cloverbud Year
- Members in multiple clubs so enroll in all clubs with all their projects at once. Do not submit one and then try to do the next. Once you submit you can not make changes
- If you are an 18-year-old member – enroll as youth not as an adult
- To be a project member, youth must be 8 AND in Third grade
- Once your enrollment has been approved, you will not be able to make any changes to your account – all changes will need to be made through Erin (Mancuso.48@osu.edu)
