Instructions for completion of forms and additional information

To be eligible for state opportunities selected at the county level (listed on the cover sheet of this packet with a # symbol), members need to complete the County Scholarship for 4-H State and National Opportunities Application and meet all of the criteria listed below. County selections are based upon participation, leadership, projects and activities, completion of 4-H story or short bio, letter of recommendation from an advisor, and the degree of interest described by the applicant. Complete applications are due at the OSU Extension Office.

Please note: If you are applying for State and National Opportunities, please check dates and be sure you are able to participate. You are also responsible for your own transportation to and from the event. For Citizenship Washington Focus, members will travel by charter bus to our nation's capital.

After the submission of your completed County Scholarship for 4-H State and National Opportunities Application, the Extension Office will contact you to set up an interview with the selection committee.

Some opportunities also require applications and registration separate from our county scholarship application. Opportunities marked with a * symbol require additional registration with each opportunity. If you are selected for an opportunity, the Extension Office can help with additional paperwork to complete the process. It is a requirement for you to write a thank you card to the scholarship sponsor of the award trip that you have been selected for. It is also a requirement for you to complete a poster after attending your trip, highlighting all of the learning experiences and aspects of your trip, to help encourage other youth to attend in the future. By being awarded a scholarship and attending a trip, you will also be asked to talk about your experience to other youth and at a Junior Leadership and/or 4-H Advisory Council meeting.







Requirement Checklist

When applying for 4-H State and National Opportunities marked with # symbol, please submit the following items:

- ✓ Your completed County Scholarship for 4-H State and National Opportunities Application
- ✓ A personal 4-H Story or Bio about applicant and picture: Please share a little bit about yourself and how 4-H has contributed to your personal development, leadership skills, and possible career plans. Please limit bio/story to no more than 2 pages.
- ✓ Letter of recommendation from an advisor in your club. Letters should be short in nature but showcase your leadership skills, your involvement in club and county 4-H activities, how they feel you could benefit from this opportunity, etc.
- ✓ A cover for your application and other materials.
