- 3) Must have taken and will continue to take a food and nutrition or sewing and textiles 4-H project or both
- 4) Must have an interest in the food and nutrition and sewing and textiles projects
- 5) Must attend meetings throughout the year
- 6) Must be able to collaborate and work with other members and advisors who are a part of the Food and Fashion Board

Responsibilities of the Food and Fashion Board members include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1) Create curriculum and skill-a-thon stations
- 2) Create activities and ideas for what to do at project clinics
- 3) Help at the project clinics
- 4) Help at Wednesday and Saturday 4-H project judging days
- 5) Type Style Review Cards for the Style Review
- 6) Help at the Style Review (announcing, showing how to model, getting members in order, etc.)
- 7) Be a mentor and help at least one younger non-family 4-H member with their food and nutrition and/or clothing and textile 4-H project(s)
- 8) Promote food and nutrition and clothing and textile 4-H projects to your 4-H Club and other members throughout Seneca County
