- 1. King and Queen contestants must be single and age 14-18 as of January 1st of this year. Minimum two years' experience with project.
- 2. Prince and Princess contestants must be ages 10-13 as of January 1st of this year. Minimum two years' experience with project.
- 3. Last year's county winner is not eligible this year but may enter future contest.
- 4. Contestants **may not** serve in another county at the same time she/he resides as royalty in Seneca County.
- 5. Contestant **may not** apply for Seneca County Jr. Fair King/Queen or species royalty at same time applying of Miscellaneous Royalty.
- 6. A schedule as to the time of the interview will be sent to the applicants. Winners will be announced at the Royalty Luncheon Saturday before the fair.
- 7. Applications must be completed and returned to the **Seneca County Junior Fair Office, PO Box 756, Tiffin or placed in the mailbox at the Youth Center** by June 15th. No late entries will be accepted.
- 8. All duties and attire are described in the Junior Fair Book in detail. The applicant must adhere to these rules and will be asked to sign a code of conduct or may be asked to forfeit their title.
- 9. The following scorecard will be used in the selecting of our Miscellaneous Royalty.
 - a. Personality and neatness 20 pts
 - b. Contestant knowledge on project represented 20 pts
 - c. Questions and answers 20 pts.
 - d. Presentation and poise 20 pts
 - e. Application and resume. 20 pts
- 10. Sashes, crowns and royalty packet and contracts will be presented at the Royalty Luncheon.

Include with this application:

- 1. One 5x7 appropriate "headshot" submitted
- 2. A letter of recommendation written by a leader/advisor from the club or organization you represent. (no more than two letters of recommendation will be accepted)
- 3. Documentation confirming your involvement in the additional activities you list as being involved in. This can be a copy of a roster, minutes of the organization, a picture in the year book, copy of certificates, etc.
- 4. An essay of 250-300 words on "What your future plans are and how your organizations have helped to form these plans".
